



The Right Honourable Dame Elizabeth Gloster, DBE PC

Liz Gloster was a Lady Justice of the Court of Appeal from 2013, and Vice-President of the Civil Division from 2016, until she retired from the court in May 2018 to return to practise as an international commercial arbitrator at One Essex Court, Temple. She was the first woman to be appointed as a Commercial Court judge in 2004 and as Judge in Charge of the Commercial Court from 2010-2012. She presided over numerous important commercial and financial markets cases, including *JP Morgan Chase Bank v Springwell Navigation Corporation* and the notable *Berezovsky v Abramovitch* trial.

Since returning to Chambers in 2018, Liz Gloster has been appointed both as chair, and co-arbitrator, in a large number, and wide range, of international arbitrations including insurance/reinsurance, banking/financial services, gas and oil (including pricing), shipping, construction projects, joint venture and BIT disputes. As a former Commercial Court and Court of Appeal Judge, Liz has extensive experience in the determination of complex factual and legal disputes. She is one of 25 members of the arbitration panel set up under the EU/UK Withdrawal Agreement. In November 2020 Liz delivered her report following her investigation into the FCA's regulation of London Capital and Finance.
